FOR THE OPERA HOUSE

Small, medium, and large-scale productions designed to use the traditional artistic bodies of the opera house. Scores are prepared to fulfill the expectations of the traditional operatic medium while providing fresh, relevant, and exciting content. These are the flagship works that constitute the operatic repertoire of IBOC.

BEYOND OPERA

Small and medium scale performances that utilize experimental, alternative, and pop techniques. Scores may be synthetic or graphic representations of the work. These works aim to test new artistic possibilities, train professional artists in small formats to build strong teams of collaborators, and develop new audiences.

TAMANDUA

Tamanduá is conceived a meeting place, whose physical symbol is water: the frontier between land and sea. the boundary separating New York from Rio, the mysterious source of life and (as blood) death. The opera's protagonists bring their hopes and desires, fears and prejudices to a series of encounters, as their fates cross at the water's edge. A larger spiritual context surrounds their experience, relating the plot to the African Brazilian religion of Candomblé and the native shamanic rituals of Pajelança.

When Ingmar Bergman wrote *The Seventh Seal*, he set his characters in the era of the Bubonic Plague. A knight returning from the crusades plays a chess match with Death. Nevertheless, the artists survive, symbolically winning over Death when all else is lost.

In the shadow of pandemic, war and climate crisis, the realization of MacDowell's operatic adaptation of Bergman's themes and characters are suddenly even more relevant and resonant.

ANITA DI LAGUNA

is an unconventional opera inspired by the life of Ana Maria Ribeiro Da Silva, known as Anita, a Brazilian guerrilla soldier that married the Italian hero Giuseppe Garibaldi. Fighting together on both sides of the Atlantic, the couple led the Brazilian rebellion in Rio Grande do Sul and the Italian Risorgimento.

"Sá is an opera work -summoning us to urgently look at Earth, our home and our only possible future."

From an invented, fictitious cosmogony, inspired by the philosopher Emanuele Coccia's idea of metamorphosis, we created SA - the first breath of life. It is from the narration of elders that the story of SÁ reaches the narrator's ears and will be transmitted onward. SÁ is the continuous and immemorial flow of life that has run through all of us since the beginning of time.

The common ancestry of all beings.

Emerged billions of years ago, from the cosmic generation of the universe, SA crosses space to land on planet Earth.

In an episodic opera, we

follow the movement of this original energy in eternal metamorphosis. On this path we follow SA, the flow of life, crossing different elements: tree, bird, sea, shell, child, mother, stone, until arriving at the present moment, in the theater where the Opera takes place.

And then, in front of its

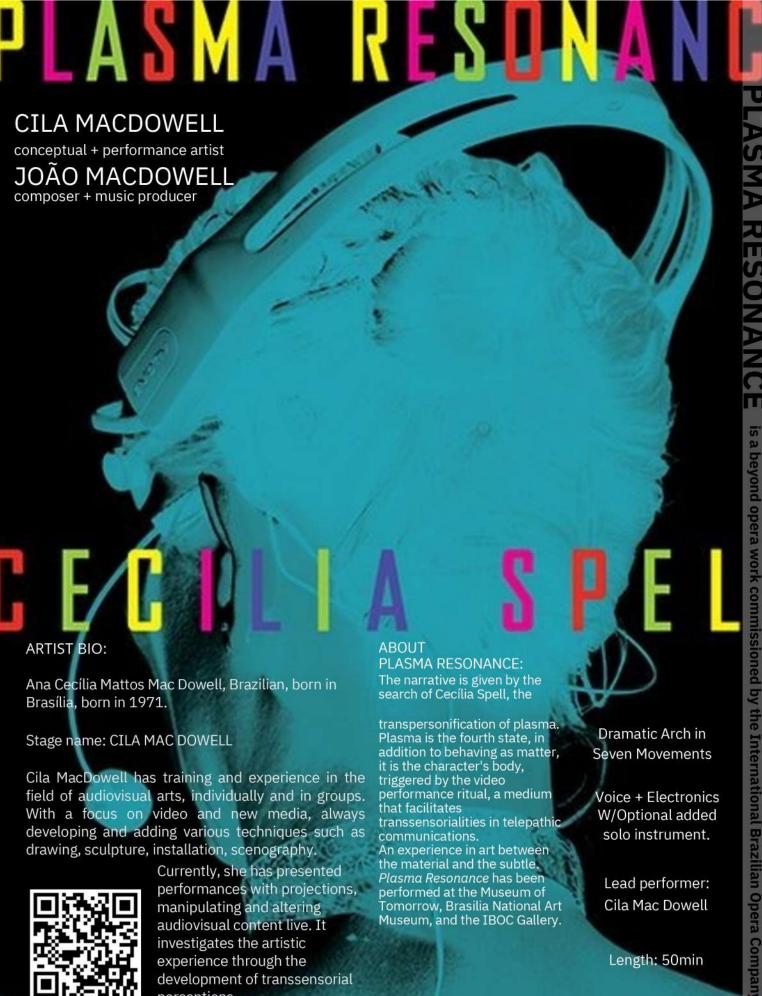
descendant audience, SÁ will now go through the last metamorphosis. Letting your legacy and your life energy pass through all the bodies present. Act I: 70m

Sá is structured around the vocal experiments that Ligiana Costa, the songwriter and singer of this project, began to carry out on her recent album Eva. An entirely vocal opera, with layers of electroacoustic sounds that emulate the sounds of nature and the Earth. On stage, Ligiana, four singers and a small choir guide us through an almost ritualistic journey.

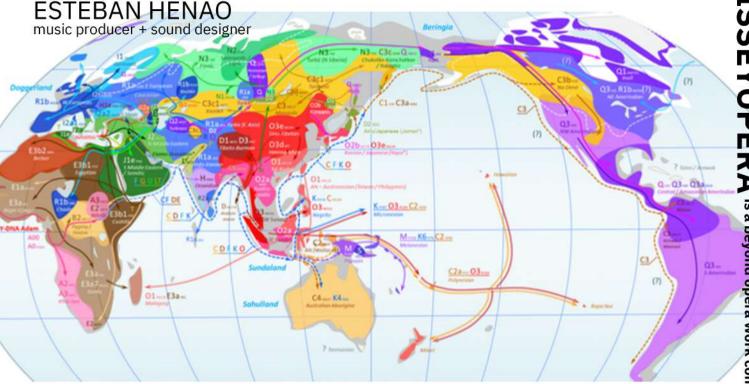

ODISSEYOPERA is an opera experienced as an installative virtual reality concert, about the walks of humanity, with music based on DNA Sonification.

OdisseyOpera presents the history of humankind and its walks around the globe that resulted in our transcultural civilization through the last 30,000 years. The opera proposal is based on 4 of the Transcuntis Mundi Project stories. The recorded scenes receive an external character - a local myth - that brings a message from the past and the future, in a monologue and music. The music creation is based on a sonification technique to a DNA Ancestry Report, which is the medium that carries direct information from our very first ancestor. It

is a celebration of human diversity and an honoring act to our heritages.

Cândida Borges is a NYC-based Brazilian composer from Bahia, a cultural melting pot. In NYC she recognized her multiethnic origins and her DNA genetic test revealed that she carries all the ethnicities of humankind.
